

The Membership Tachometer by Mona Cox





Back To School by Rick Milsow (CMCS President)



This past month we conducted our umpteenth School Daze event at Pacific Raceways. The day was a great success marred only by one off track expedition, which caused considerable damage to both the car and the driver's pride.

We had 64 drivers turn out for the event and they brought Corvettes, Porsches, WRXs, Lotus, Camaro, GTO, Mustang, and even a Cadillac (but not your father's Cadillac). If it sounds like a gathering of horsepower and iron (with a lot of composite fiberglass) it was.

Here is a sample of the comments we received:

"All, I just wanted to say thank you very much. I participated in the Corvette Driving event a Pacific Raceway yesterday. I can't remember when I had so much fun.... Driving into turn 3a, hitting the apex then on the gas to 3b, rotating the car to that apex, through 5 and 6, on the gas through 7 to 8, hitting that apex then turn 2. Turn 2 was very cool when I hit it right. I know it was much slower than the fast guys but it was really cool to me. Wow. What a day. Then I'm headed home on I-5, traffic stops and I'm in the same car listening to the radio with the air on, idling smooth as silk. Wow. Thanks for the day". Rick Sturrock

Rick drove down from Blaine to attend School Daze.

During the day drivers had four opportunities to spend about 25 minutes on the 2.25 mile road course with its 10 turns and long half mile straight. We scheduled people in run groups based on their track skills, and placed instructors, when we could, in the passenger seat of beginners who needed some coaching; and when the beginners finished their stint they were able to watch the advanced drivers demonstrate how well these cars perform on the road course.

Shoreline Community College students again assisted us by serving as corner workers and proved to be invaluable through out the day. These students are in the General Motors ASEP program under the guidance of Scott Main and gladly volunteer to work the corners for us. Some have even graduated from the program and keep coming back year after year to help us out. It might be the rides the advanced drivers give them during the lunch hour that keeps them coming back.

Also during the lunch hour, we conducted our very first parade lap. A dozen or so cars participated in this slow, two-lap tour of the road course. Those who went along included people who don't drive in the event, a driver who took his father for a ride in his car, and a visitor (in another Cadillac CTS-V) with his three young boys followed me twice around the road course. I think we'll be seeing that visitor back next

year, ready to drive in the beginner's group.

Sixty four drivers, ten Shoreline students, a whole pack of volunteers, and a number of visitors all had a great time at Pacific Raceways July 13th, 2005. *Rick Milsow*.

Sunday morning awards were presented, directions given, and off to more picturesque driving and bridges. (Of these 7, the Larwood Bridge, over the Roaring and






Crabtree Creeks and the Stayton/Jordan Bridge were my personal favorites.)


